The Brooklyn Transfer Station will be collecting electronic waste the first Saturday of each month starting Saturday, May 7, 2011. The following electronic equipment will be accepted:

Computers (personnel computers, mainframes, mid-range computers, laptops); networking equipment (hubs, switches, control cards, etc.); computer monitors; televisions, printers; keyboards; mice; adaptors; stereos; speakers; VCRs; scanners, fax machines; copiers; telephones and telephone systems; computer wire and cable; computer drives and storage devices (floppy drives, CD ROMs, hard drives); power supplies; circuit boards; microwaves; air conditioners; scrap aluminum; (machine and machine parts, cable extrusion, etc.); scrap copper (cable, pipe, etc.); UPS (uninterrupted power supply) batteries; and related computer and electronic equipment.

It is recommended that all hard drives be removed from any computers before disposal.

Upon arrival to the Transfer Station, residents are asked to notify the Landfill Attendant of the electronic waste items you are disposing.
