c) Next Generation Accountability

Mrs. Michaud gave an explanation of the academic goals and standards of the elementary students, and expectations for the future.

Mr. Yanku gave an overview of the STAR Assessment scores in reading and math in grades 5 through 8, and goals and expectations for future scores.

Dr. Conway gave an explanation of the the Connecticut Next Generation Accountability System. She reviewed Brooklyn's scores for the 2014/15 and 2015/16 school years.

d) Pre-Kindergarten Program

Mrs. Michaud provided an update to Board of Education members on the the district's pre-kindergarten program. She explained that because the rigors of kindergarten have increased, the rigors of pre-kindergarten also need to increase in that it serves as a stepping stone. She suggested changing the language from pre-kindergarten registration to pre-kindergarten application. She also stated that she would like to see the school readiness students spread out throughout all the pre-kindergarten classrooms, rather than being podded together in one classroom.
