## 5. New Business

a. Discussion on Proposed Solar Panel Projects at the Elementary and Middle School- Patti Buell and Roger LaFleur: The Board of Education is proposing to put solar panels on the schools. This is a reimbursable project through the State at 72%. The proposed figures include preventative maintenance.

Sandra Brodeur made a motion the Board of Finance is in approval of a project plan presented for two solar panel projects at the Brooklyn Schools with estimated project budgets for which sum to 1,552,281 and if approved we urge the BOE and consulting engineer and the Towns general government to move forward to implement the portion of this necessary by June 30<sup>th</sup>. Ken Dykstra seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

- b. Action on 2017-18 Tax Suspense List Prepared by Tax Collector: The board reviewed the lists given by the tax collector. Sandra Brodeur made a motion to put the given figures onto the suspense list for collection. Ken Dykstra seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.
- c. Discussion aimed at Revising Budget Actions taken on 5/14/18, in view of additional Tax Revenue
  - i. Source of Additional Revenue
  - ii. Application of Additional Revenue to Budget and Uncommitted Reserve

    Mr. Ives states there was an error in the collected automobile taxes and it was
    higher than reported. He feels because of this the mill increase does not need to be
    1.25. Discussion held, and the board agrees they still want to build the reserve.
    Sandra Brodeur made a motion to increase the mill rate by 1 mill. Kim Conroy
    seconded the motion. This will give the reserve a balance slightly above 1.830
    million dollars. In-favor 2 (Conroy & Brodeur) Nay 1 (Dykstra) Chairman Otto states
    he will not vote against the motion. Motion carries.
- d. Finalization of Proposed Budget for 2018-19
  - i. General Government Budget
  - ii. Board of Education Budget
  - iii. Capital Budget

Mr. Ives requests presenting the capital budget first because it is incorporated in the general government budget.

Kim Conroy made a motion to approve the capital budget and present to the tax payers in the amount of \$744,040; general government in the amount of 5,542,199; and board of education in the amount of \$18,275,435. Sandra Brodeur seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.
