**Board of Selectmen Regular Meeting Minutes** Thursday, May 25, 2017 6:30pm Clifford B. Green Memorial Center

Present: Rick Ives, Bob Kelleher, Joe Voccio and Melissa Bradley; Recording Secretary

Also Present: Ken Dykstra, David Fuss and Aaron Kerouack

- 1. Call to Order: Mr. Ives called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

  2. Approve Previous Minutes: Joe Voccio made a motion to approve the meeting minutes of the state of the st 4/27/17 as presented. Bob Kelleher seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-07
- 3. Public Comment: None
- 4. Discussion on 2016-17 Budget: No more ECS payments will be coming, leaving the revenues short about \$52,000. Mashentucket is still expected to be received, as well as municipal sharing and MERSA. The DUI grant is done for this year, spending and receiving.

In the expenses, there were bills for JKS from 2014 & 2015 that were not paid. This totals approximately \$8,000.

The school expects to return about \$80,000 to the reserve. Dr. Conway is still dealing with transportation issue.

Bob Kelleher made a motion to add set town meeting date to the agenda after item #5. Joe Voccio seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.

- 5. Discussion on 2017-18 Budget: No changes to discuss
- 5a. Set Town Meeting Date: Bob Kelleher made a motion to set the annual town meeting for Wednesday, June 21, 2017 at the Brooklyn Middle School beginning at 7:00pm. Joe Voccio seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.
- 6. Discussion/Action on Treasurer Appointment: Mr. Ives states in the absence of the finance director, he will be appointing a treasurer next week.

- 7. Discussion/Action on Annual SEC for ADV part 2 offer/Hooker & Holcombe: Hooker and Holcombe sent a letter giving the Town the option to opt out of sharing our information. The board agrees to opt out.
- 8. Discussion on Speeding Enforcement: There have been many complaints in Town regarding speeding and accidents have occurred as well due to speed. Mr. Ives, in conjunction with the Resident Trooper, will be tasked with added enforcement. The speed sign will also be used next week. Mr. Ives is hopeful the additional presence of Trooper Corradi will slow people down and make our roads safer.
- 9. Update on Memorial Day/Family Fun Day: All preparations are complete for the parade and fun day. The forecast is not looking good. Mr. Ives states he will make the call by 6:30 that morning if they are not going to proceed.
- 10. Single Family Dwellings: No discussion
- 11. Calls for Service: No discussion
- 12. Other Business: Mr. Ives states he is still working on the issue the NECCOG engineering. He will discuss further at a later meeting. A formal schedule for the Tech Park should be received in the next ten days.
  - Mr. Voccio states he will be scheduling a capital meeting in the next week or so.
- **13. Approve Bills:** Bob Kelleher made a motion to approve the bills in the amount of \$26,122.46, voucher #1110. Joe Voccio seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.
- **14. Public Comment:** Aaron Kerouack question what is happening with Tiffany Place. Mr. Ives clarifies the activities and that they proceed through the housing authority.
  - Mr. Kerouack also suggests having the trooper enforce illegal parking. It is happening on streets and in parking lots. Mr. Ives agrees this needs to be addressed, but this may be a job more suitable for a traffic cop or constable. Mr. Ives will check into the constable ordinance to see if they can still be appointed.
- **15. Adjourn:** Joe Voccio made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Bob Kelleher seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned at 7:25pm.
