Board of Selectmen Regular Meeting Minutes Thursday, May 31, 2018 6:30pm Clifford B. Green Memorial Center

BA Badeo Mos IJ had Present: Rick Ives, Joe Voccio, Wayne Jolley and Melissa Bradley; Recording Secretary

Also Present: Ken Dykstra, Aaron Kerouack and WINY radio

1. Call to Order: Mr. Ives called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

- 2. Approve Minutes: Wayne Jolley made a motion to approve the previous minutes. Rick Ives seconded the motion. Joe Voccio states he was not present for the meeting. Motion passed 2-1 abstain (Voccio)
- 3. Public Comment: None
- 4. Discussion on 2017-18 Financials: State Aid Excess Cost and Special Education should both be zero. They were not supposed to be shown as revenues, they were netted. The Board of Finance expenses are over budget due to auditor's issues. An extra payment to East Brooklyn Fire Department is showing, this will be fixed. Snow and ice will go back to zero, those expenses will be paid out of TAR. The double posting of the HSA is still in the process of being corrected. The current budget is \$644,000 to the good.
- 5. Discussion on 2018-19 Budget: There is a \$223,000 difference between expenses and revenues which will be resolved with the mill increase.
- 6. Discussion and Update on MS4 Project: DEEP will have a template for the education portion to bring awareness to residents. Mr. Ives states we will go out to bid for the software portion needed for inventory. At the end of the fiscal year 2019, we will have to begin collecting samples.
- 7. Discussion on Grandview Terrace Subdivision: A portion of this road was deeded to the Town years ago and should not have been. The subdivision has since expired, and Brooklyn Builders is requesting the Town to deed the road back to them. Discussion ensued.

Wayne Jolley made a motion to deed the road back to the original owner. Joe Voccio seconded the motion. Mr. Ives will have the Town Attorney draw up the necessary paperwork. Motion passed 3-0.

- **8. Discussion on Annual Town Meeting:** The annual budget meeting will be held on June 7th at 7pm in the middle school auditorium.
- 9. Single Family Dwellings: No discussion
- 10. Calls for Service: No discussion
- 11. Approve Bills: Joe Voccio made a motion to pay voucher #1112 in the amount of \$72,382.15; voucher #1113 in the amount of \$787.65; voucher #1115 in the amount of \$300; voucher #1117 in the amount of \$20,608.94; and voucher #1118 in the amount of \$569.55. Wayne Jolley seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.
- **12. Other Business:** Ken Dykstra suggests a robo call to residents to announce the town meeting. It will also be advertised on the website, signs around Town, and the Bulletin.
- 13. Public Comment: None
- **14. Adjourn:** Joe Voccio made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Wayne Jolley seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned at 7:00pm.
