- 1. Call to Order: Austin Tanner called the meeting to order at 9:02am.
- 2. Approve Previous Minutes: Lou Brodeur made a motion to approve the minutes of 10/14/2021 as presented. Austin Tanner seconded the motion. Motion passed 2-0.
- 3. Public Comment: None

4. Appointments

- Lou Brodeur made a motion reappoint James Soler as a citizen member to the board of fire commissioners, term expiring 12/2/2024. Austin Tanner seconded the motion.

- Lou Brodeur made a motion to reappoint Austin Tanner and Lou Brodeur as regular members, term expiring 11/16/2026 to Resource Recovery. Austin Tanner seconded the motion. Motion passed.
- BRRC: Discussion/Action on Rick Ives seat: Austin would like to table this until he can speak with Rick.

5. Discussion on Financials: No discussion

Lou Brodeur made a motion to add the approval of the pension report from Hooker & Holcomb to the agenda as 5a.
