The following language will be included in the Ordinance draft:

2-40.9 D. All complaints relative to sexual harassment, shall be filed with the First Selectman of the Town for investigation, unless the complaint is against the First Selectman of the Town.

Jules reported that after speaking to the State Ethics Attorney there is no state ethics code on sexual harassment.

Jules spoke to Charles Krich from CCHR on handling or reporting sexual harassment. Mr. Krich stated someone locally would need to respond to the complaint immediately, usually it's the First Selectman. He said the complaint can be kept private under executive session while the Board of the Selectman investigate. Ethics only role would be to handle the investigation if the complaint is against the First Selectman.
