safety of the students.

**Proposed Project:** To provide safety of all students, the project will ensure control over building

keys and to give first responders access to any locked interior door with a single

key.

**Scope of Work and Specifications:** 

Make every interior lock on both schools operate with a single new master key

Use existing Sargent hardware whenever possible

Ensure ADA compliance

Ensure all hardware is ANSI grade 1

Administration and select other areas to be operated by a separate key

Estimated number of rekeys is between 350-375

Estimated number of doors needing new hardware is between 75-100

**<u>Completion of Work:</u>** To be completed as soon as possible with no disruption to the instructional day

May require afternoon/evening work hours to complete the work

Bidders are required to verify hardware needs

Bid should include a fee proposal to complete all work and expense schedule Bidders must have professional references and quality past performance record

All work areas must be left as found each night
