7. 2014-2015 Budget Discussion/ Capital

The Director would like to have a small group to work on the budget before it is presented to the full commission to be discussed. Potential additions to the budget:

Part-time maintenance position Program Coordinator /full time – to handle new programs for children on vacation, holidays, school closings, manage the Before and After School programs, and direct Summer Camp. Still developing the position, revenue could increase substantially. Fun Day will be managed by the Recreation department Capital- If the maintenance position is added another truck will be needed.

8. Other Business

BOF- referred Carealot to the Recreation Commission—The Commission made it clear they are welcome to present to the Commission.

The tennis court lights have been moved to inside the building that houses the Boy Scout equipment. This does not allow the Rec. Dept, to set the lights for the tennis courts as the Rec. Dept does not have a key. The First Selectman is looking at moving the box to outside the building to allow for this. The electricity for this building is paid for under the Recreation Budget.

The Prince Hill Building still has asbestos in it that must be removed before the building can come down.
