1. **Call to Order:** Mr. Ives called the meeting to order at 7:15pm.
2. **Public Comment:** None
3. **Approve Previous Minutes:** Joe Voccio made a motion to approve the previous minutes of October 26, 2017 as presented. Wayne Jolley seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.
4. **Discussion on Financials:** Financials are on target. Bulky waste is a little slower with the cold weather. Mr. Ives is talking with Pomfret regarding their residents using Brooklyn's transfer station. Advertising this will help get the word out.
5. **Discussion on Household Hazardous Waste Day:** This cost is approximately \$8,000 and with the State budget cuts, may not be feasible this budget year. It will be considered for the fall.
6. **Update on Electrical:** There will be a new panel being installed in the next thirty days. The service will increase by Eversource and should resolve the power draw issue from the highway garage.
7. **Attendant Report:** The scale can be touchy in the cold weather, especially with ice and snow. Mr. Benson made T-beams for it and seems to be helping. Lisa does not believe the State has been out in 2 years to calibrate the scale and questions if the company that goes to Mr. Jolley's business could come service the landfills? Mr. Ives believes they were out recently and will check into it. Lisa received the bag inventory clipboard from Russell and is keeping track. The swap shed is still having issues of bulky waste and junk being left in it. Mr. Ives asked if the sign
