1. Call to Order: Rick Ives called the meeting to order at 7:40pm.

- **2. Public Comment:** Aaron Kerouack questions if a pick up could be scheduled for elderly residents on the hazardous waste day? Mr. Ives will address this in item 6.
- **3. Approve Minutes:** Bob Lee made a motion to approve the previous minutes as presented. Joe Voccio seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.
- **4. Discussion on Financials:** Casella had discussed increasing their fee but the market has moved back into their favor so Mr. Ives does not believe they will pursue this.
- **5. Discussion on Construction Debris:** A complaint was made about burying concrete and asphalt. The board agrees this is acceptable fill and there are no issues in burying it.
- **6. Discussion on Hazardous Waste Day:** Hazordous waste day will be scheduled for the fall. Mr. Ives will begin planning. Mr. Ives states he looked into picking up for residents but it because an insurance issue and the Town cannot be liable transporting hazardous waste.
- **7. Discussion on Summer Schedule:** Discussion held on opening one more day a week for the month of August from 10-5. Mr. Ives will discuss more and decide which day would be best.
- **8. Attendants Report:** Lisa Fuss states there is controversy over a sign that is hung that says all garbage must be in green bags however if it weighed as bulky over the scale, it is accepted in different bags. The sign will be modified to read green bags only unless load is weighed over the scale.

Items being left at the swap shed is getting out of control. Car seats is the biggest item left that cannot be for safety reasons. A sign will be made "NO CAR SEATS"

Donation bins have not been emptied. They do not seem to be on a regular schedule any longer.

9. Other Business: Mr. Voccio states the school roof project will be starting soon and they will have dumpsters on site. Some material may come to the transfer stations, but minimal.

An electrician will be coming the second week of July to look at the electrical issues between the garage and transfer station.
