SPECIAL TOWN MEETING MINUTES  
APRIL 7, 2022 7PM  
MIDDLE SCHOOL AUDITORIUM & ZOOM

The Town Clerk, Kate Bisson, called the meeting to order at 7:06pm. A motion was made to nominate Bob Kelleher for the evening's moderator by Lou Brodeur, seconded by Sandy Brodeur. No other nominations were made, motion carried.

1. A motion was made by Jeff Otto and seconded by Lou Brodeur for the purposes of discussion to consider and act upon the proposed "Smoking Ordinance." Discussion followed and a vote was taken; motion carried.
2. A motion was made by Jeff Otto and seconded by Lou Brodeur for the purposes of discussion to consider and action upon the proposed amendments to the Town's purchasing ordinance. Discussion followed and a vote was taken; motion carried.
3. A motion was made by Jeff Otto and seconded by Heather Allen for the purposes of discussion to consider and act upon the Resolution allowing the Board of Selectmen to use the sum of \$53,000 returned to the Town from the Quinebaug Regional Technology Park towards the cost of a new roof at the former Town Garage at 61 South Main Street. Discussion followed and a vote was taken; motion carried.
4. A motion was made by Jeff Otto and seconded by Lou Brodeur for the purpose of discussion to consider and act upon the Resolution allowing the Board of Selectmen to use up to \$74,000 of the State LOCIP money towards the cost of constructing a new roof at the former Town Garage at 61 South Main Street. Discussion followed and a vote was taken; motion carried.

Hearing no other business to come before the Town Meeting, a motion was made to adjourn at 7:37pm by Jeff Otto, seconded by Lou Brodeur; motion carried.
