The Brooklyn Water Pollution Control Authority held a special meeting on Thursday, February 28, 2013 at the Brooklyn Town Hall on the following:

Present: David Fuss, Donald S. Francis, Gerard Renaud, Robert Kiley, Craig Dunlop and Sherri A. Soucy

Also Present: Joseph Couture-United Water and Virgil Lloyd-Fuss & O'Neill

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman David Fuss.

A motion was made by Gerard Renaud to approve meeting minutes from November 27, 2012 and January 22, 2013 as presented. Robert Kiley seconded the motion. All members in favor, so voted.

Joseph Couture from United Water reported to the commission that there was a blockage at the McDonald's business. There were excessive amounts of grease. Parent Sanitation called the treatment plant regarding the blockage. It was found that there was grease in the lateral from McDonalds. The lateral was jetted and excessive amounts of grease were being released into the sewer main. McDonalds needs to empty their grease trap on a more frequent basis and when their lateral becomes plugged and Parent Sanitation relieves the blockage, the grease/slug is released into the sewer collection system.

Sherri reported to the commission that certified letters were sent out to McDonalds in regards to this issue and she will report to the commission at the next meeting regarding any discussions.

Virgil Lloyd from Fuss & O'Neill updated the commission on the Tatnic Pump Station Project. (See Attached). The Facilities Planning report will be updated and will be sent to DEEP for review. Virgil will also review the numbers for the pros and cons to install submersible pumps at the existing station.

A motion was made by Gerard Renaud to approve the monthly bills for the amount of \$199,201.44. (CL&P/\$1311.92, Fuss & O'Neill/\$3332.23, KWPCA/\$1415.70, Saveway/\$164.42, Sherri Soucy/\$100.00, The Bulletin/\$520.11 and Town of Killingly/\$192357.06) Craig Dunlop seconded the motion. All members in favor so moved.

A motion was made by Gerard Renaud to adjourn at 8:40 PM. Craig Dunlop seconded the motion. All members in favor so voted.
