- Kelly Codding presented the idea of having a student rep or liason from each of the high schools that our Brooklyn students attend.
 - Possibly have a HS rep from each of the schools that our Brooklyn kids attend to present at the Board meetings
- Ensure that quality curriculum is taught to the teachers in an effective manner
- Dr. Berry mentioned that there are school improvement plans but they are not widespread.
- The Board members will provide their thoughts for goals they would like to see added to our 2016 goals by 1/26 to Aimee Genna
- Aimee will collect the goals, consolidate the ideas and present the full list to the Board at the Feb. 2nd budget meeting
- The list of goals will be compared to the policy manual to determine a final set of goals for the 2016 calendar year
