- 1. Call to Order: Mr. Otto called the meeting to order at 7:01pm.
- 2. Public Comment: None
- **3. Approve Previous Minutes:** Kim Conroy made a motion to approve the previous minutes of 5/10/2017. Sandra Brodeur seconded the motion. Motion passed 6-0.
- 4. Discussion/Action Transfer Town Clerk Reserve Funds: Mr. Ives explains the Town Clerk has a fund with approximately \$8,900. Generally, the funds are used for document preservation. All documents are currently up to date. The concern is with the temperature control of the office and vault. The vault temperature needs to be controlled for the documents. There is one air conditioning zone that controls from the Assessor's office the Clerk's office. There can be a 20-degree difference from one to other. The clerk is requesting to use \$6,400 of the fund to create a separate zone for the office. An RFP went out and one bid was received. \$6,100 is for labor and \$300 is advertising costs. Sandra Brodeur made a motion to authorize the transfer of funds from the Town Clerk Reserve Funds to be used for the temperature control project. Drew Dionne seconded the motion. Motion passed 6-0.
- 5. Review of the 2017-18 Budget: Mr. Ives states there will be no pilot, revenue sharing, or Mashantucket revenue in next year's budget. The remaining state revenues have been promised by OPM.

After discussion, no changes were made to the budget.
