Board of Selectmen Regular Meeting Minutes

Thursday, May 12, 2016
6:30pm Clifford B. Green Memorial Center

Present: Selectmen - Richard Ives, and Joe Voccio; Recording Secretary - Melissa Bradley Brad

TOWN OF FEK

- 1. Call to Order: Mr. Ives called the meeting to order at 6:33pm.
- 2. Approve Meeting Minutes: Joe Voccio made a motion to approve the minutes of 4/28/16 as presented. Rick Ives seconded the motion. Motion passed 2-0.
- 3. Public Comment: None
- 4. Set Meeting Dates for Resource Recovery: Rick Ives made a motion to hold the Resource Recovery meetings the last Thursday of each month immediately following the Selectmen's meeting. Joe Voccio seconded the motion. Motion passed 2-0.
- Discussion/Action on Sidewalk Committee: A clerk of the works will be needed for this project. They will have paperwork to do as well as concrete testing. Mr. Ives proposes a three-person committee consisting of Joe Voccio, David Fuss and Tom Rukstella. Bob Kelleher made a motion to authorize the First Selectman to form a three-person committee to include J. Voccio, D. Fuss and T. Rukstella to oversee the sidewalk project. Joe Voccio seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.
- 6. Discussion on Flag Pole at Town Hall: The current flag pole at the Town Hall is located in the front of the building on the top of the roof. The ropes are constantly twisting and fray which causes them to break. Flagman of America, a company in Avon, CT came to assess the current situation. They also gave a quote for a self-standing pole. The fix the current structure, the cost is approximately \$3,000 and for the self-standing pole, approximately \$2,000. The self-standing pole would have the hardware inside the pole which would remain locket to ensure the ropes will not be vandalized. Mr. Ives did call the company to discuss the twisting on the roof because it seems the current proposal will not solve that but they have not called back yet. If a selfstanding pole is decided, the decision of where to place it will need to be made. The island directly in the front of the Town Hall is primarily owned by the State. The Town only owns a small portion. Mr. Ives is waiting to speak with the salesman from the company and will report back at the next meeting.

- 7. Discussion on 2015-16 Budget: Mr. Ives reports there was an unexpected tax collection of approximately \$40,000 today.
- 8. Discussion on 2016-17 Budget: Mr. Ives received some correspondence from the USDA regarding a lending rate of 2.78% for 15 years for the highway department vehicles requested in capital. Mr. Ives states the rate is good, though he is uncertain about the length of the loan exceeding the life of the trucks. The Board of Finance will be meeting immediately after this meeting and the Selectmen agree to recess and hold this discussion afterwards, if need be.
- 9. Set Annual Town Meeting Date: Joe Voccio made a motion to set the Annual Town Meeting date on June 7th, 2016, details will be identified in the call of the meeting. Bob Kelleher seconded the motion. The hearing is scheduled for May 23rd, 2016 and the Board of Finance will be setting that this evening. Motion passed 3-0.
- 10. Single Family Dwellings: No discussion.
- 11. Calls for Service: No discussion.
- 12. Liaison Reports: The Board of Education went into a lengthy executive session with no outcome.

13. Other Business

- A regional revenue collector is being discussed. More details to follow.
- There are discussions of having municipalities handling vehicle registrations, much like how AAA currently does.
- 14. Approve Bills: Joe Voccio made a motion to approve the bills in the amount of \$115,746.55. Bob Kelleher seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.
- 15. Public Comment: None

Joe Voccio made a motion to recess the meeting to reserve the option to reconvene after the Board of Finance meeting. Bob Kelleher seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0. Meeting recessed at 6:55pm.

Joe Voccio made a motion to come out of recess at 8:35pm. Rick Ives seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.

16. Adjourn: Joe Voccio made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Bob Kelleher seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned at 8:35pm.
