1. **Call to Order:** Mr. Ives called the meeting to order at 6:31pm. Mr. Ives welcomes newly elected Selectman Wayne Jolley.
2. **Approve Previous Minutes:** Joe Voccio made a motion to approve the minutes of 10/26/17 as presented. Rick Ives seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.
3. **Public Comment:** None
4. **Appointments & Resignations:** Wayne Jolley made a motion to accept the resignation from Peter Considine from fire commissioners. Joe Voccio seconded the motion. Mr. Considine is experiencing health issues and is unable to serve at this time. Mr. Voccio states it is with regret to accept his resignation and wish him well. Motion passed 3-0.

Joe Voccio made a motion to accept the resignation from David Fuss from Planning and Zoning and Water Pollution Control, effective November 8th. Wayne Jolley seconded the motion. Mr. Voccio thanks Mr. Fuss for his service on both boards for many years. Motion passed 3-0.

5. **Discussion on 2017-18 Financials:** No discussion
6. **Discussion on 2017-18 Budget:** There may be more cuts made in January from the State, but will not know until then. The board of finance requested the General Government and Board of Education split the shortfall from the 2016-17 budget. This will be just over \$60,000 each.
7. **Set Next Year's Meeting Dates:** Joe Voccio made a motion to adopt the 2018 meeting dates as presented. Wayne Jolley seconded the motion. Complete list attached. Motion passed 3-0.
8. **Set Town Meeting Date and Call:** Mr. Ives suggests December 14th for the Town Meeting. The Ethics ordinance will be presented for adoption, Line of Credit for approval and Board of Education shortfall. The Housing Authority has offered to sell the community center to the Town

for \$1 but Mr. Ives does not believe this would be prepared in time for this Town Meeting. Joe Voccio made a motion to set the Town Meeting date of December 14, in the middle school auditorium at 7:00pm, pending availability. Wayne Jolley seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.

9. **Discussion on Boards & Commissions:** There are several board and commissions that need volunteers. Planning and Zoning is becoming an issue and Water Pollution Control currently has a lot going on and needs someone to take over. Mr. Ives asks for any volunteers to fill an application out.
10. **Highway Department Staffing Update:** There was a retirement in the department and that position was posted and interviews began. Mr. Ives believes they are ready to make an offer.
11. **Single Family Dwellings** No discussion
12. **Calls for Service:** No service
13. **Approve Bills:** No bills to approve
14. **Public Comment:** None
15. **Adjourn:** Joe Voccio made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Wayne Jolley seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned at 6:55pm.





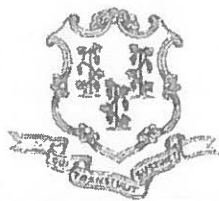
