- **1. Call to Order:** Rick Ives called the meeting to order at 6:31pm.

- **9. "Call" For Volunteers Update:** The Planning & Zoning commission is in need of members. Mr. Ives asks that anyone that is interested to please contact him, or for any board/commission.
- **10. Earth Day Update:** Earth Day will be held on April 21st from 9-1 at the Community Center. There will be free bulky waste drop off for residents at the land fill. The State Police will be conducting a drug take-back program at the community center from 9-12.

12. Other Business: Mr. Voccio states the outstanding mortgage on Quebec Square is between \$300-\$400,000 and should be paid off next year.
