1. Call to Order: Mr. Ives called the meeting to order at 6:31pm.

2. Approve Minutes: Rick Ives made a motion to approve the minutes of 7/12/18 as presented. Wayne Jolley seconded the motion. Mr. Voccio states he was not present for the meeting. Motion passed 2-1 (Voccio abstain)

3. Public Comment: None

- 4. Discussion on 2017-18 Financials: The tax deposits have been deconstructed and there is still \$235,000 in the incorrect account. This should be completed shortly. An accountant has been hired on a temporary basis to help out in the department. The auditor firm was changed to King & King Associates.
- 5. Discussion on Town Dead End Roads: There have been requests, primarily on Paradise Lake and Tripp Hollow Road, to have a second exit. Mr. Ives would like to discuss ideas on how to accomplish this. The owner of the property on Tripp Hollow Road who has allowed the bus to turn around in their driveway has requested they longer do. The Town will need to look into making the turnaround. Mr. Ives suggests setting up a subcommittee to discuss and brainstorm. Mr. Ives would like some ideas of who to have on the committee for the next meeting. Mr. Jolley offers to help Mr. Voccio out with the subcommittee.
- 6. Discussion on Town Auditor: Pomfret sent an RFP out for a new auditing firm and included Brooklyn. Two RFP's were received, and King & King were chosen by both Towns.
- 7. Single Family Dwellings: No discussion
- 8. Calls for Service: No discussion

- **9. Other Business:** Bills were not ready today. Mr. Ives will contact the Selectmen when they are finished.
- **10. Public Comment:** Aaron Kerouack states all statutory requirements pertaining to Grandview Terrace have not been met and should not be voted on at the Town Meeting this evening.
- **11. Adjourn:** Joe Voccio made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Wayne Jolley seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned at 6:57pm.
