II. Discussion on new capital requests: Andrew Dionne advised the committee that the Board of Finance is looking for all requests to be submitted by March 27<sup>th</sup>. There will be a special meeting conducted before the March 27<sup>th</sup> deadline.

Gene Michael Deary asked about Fire Alarm and Security system as to why there were two separate companies. There are currently three different systems. The goal is to have Simplex Grinnell in the Elementary School, along with the type that was installed during the gymnasium renovation at the middle school. The reason for this is that Simplex Grinnell services both types of systems, so both schools will be serviced by the same company.

## V. Discussion on special meeting:

Gene Michael Deary would like a list of technology inventory and would like to see the 3-5 year outlook regarding retention of inventory.

Andrew Dionne also wanted the committee members to keep in mind for next year's budget that the town hall will be in need of a server with an estimated price tag of \$100,000.

Misc. paving repairs, moving traffic lane to rear of school, repaving of all three schools Other items on the list will need to be discussed and confirmed with Dave Kowolenko.
