Roll Call showed eight members present. Two absent

IV. Adoption of Minutes:

Regular meeting minutes of October 3, 2012-Deane Rettig moved to adopt minutes of October 3, 2012. Don Francis seconds this motion. All in favor. Motion passed.

Special Meeting Minutes of October 16, 2012-Deane Rettig moved to adopt minutes of October 16, 2012. Don Francis seconds this motion. All in favor. Motion passed.

Carlene Kelleher made a motion that the following changes be reflected in the Special Meeting Minutes of October 16, 2012 to read as follows: Section V.- Scott Denzel of Sampsonics Computers, 23 Wauregan Road, Map 24 Lot 135, VCD Zone, Sign permit request in VCD. Chuck Dobrowski agreed the sign was in compliance but it is the P&Z Commission authority to approve permit for sign. All in favor. Henry Moses abstains.

The minutes read as if there was only one committee established. There were two. One is an adhoc committee of commission, who will advise the P&Z Commission how we want o react to the Rte 169 committee chaired by Jules D'Agostino. The other committee will be an ongoing advisory committee to the town. All in favor

 - a. Reading of Legal Notice:

Michelle Sigfridson reads the legal notice into the record.

- b. Continued Public Hearings:
 - Modification to previously approved application (August 3, 2011) SP11-003 Courtesy Ford, 455 Providence Road, Map 41, Lot 114, PC Zone, Proposed building addition to existing automobile sales facility.

Terry Chambers presented an "as built" for the site. Discussed changes made to the plan, sidewalks, slopes, proposed employee parking. The proposed employee parking area will have 38 parking spaces for employee rather than the original proposal of 54 spaces. It was stated at the last meeting that the commission did not wish to review the landscaping plan until an updated, accurate "as built" was completed. The landscaping plan has not had any changes from what was presented at the last meeting. Carlene Kelleher brought up the subject regarding the excess percentage amount of excess pavement. Terry Chambers discussed the options to resolve this issue, (buy additional land, rip up pavement, make pavement pervious). He stated the regulations allow for a 5% "bonus" for servicing of more than one property from a common access point. The other 5% "bonus" allowance falls under an access management plan. The other option would be to request a variance from the ZEO.

Carlene Kelleher voiced her concern with respect to the over paved impervious paved area. Terry Chambers stated if the commission granted the 5% "bonus" allowance for access management plan which would bump up the lot coverage allowance to 70% which would leave 1.6% that could be worked out by Courtesy Ford. The pervious pavement and/or ripping out of pavement will be addressed with Syl Pauly.

The Commission will discuss with Attorney Alters the request for a variance and if the access management plan is an option.

Terry Chambers requested on behalf of Courtesy Ford that the public hearing be continued. Henry Moses made a motion to grant the extension request of the Public Hearing. Deane Rettig seconds his motion. All in favor. Motion passed.

Henry Moses made a motion to continue the Public Hearing to the next scheduled meeting on December 5, 2012. Craig Dunlop seconds this motion. All in favor. Motion passed.

c. New Public Hearings:

 Private School Definition. The language was presented with Commission member packets. Jim Larkin clarified the regulation changes the Commission approved at the last meeting. To allow private schools in the RA zone, subject to a Special Permit. @. To add the definitions of Private School and Municipal Facilities.

Lisa Arends, Allen Hill Rd addressed the commission regarding language for private schools and handling dormitories or conversion of single family homes for dormitory uses. She asked the Commission to consider these issues when looking at definition of Private Schools so we are forward thinking as opposed to dealing with a chain reaction after the fact.

Henry Moses made a motion to close the public hearing. Deane Rettig seconds this motion. All in favor. Motion passed.

Tom Doherty made a motion to add to the next planning meeting agenda the review of collection centers and review of dormitories. Deane Rettig seconds this motion stating it should be listed at the end of the agenda.
