It didn't really cross my mind as it was just yard work to me. Mrs. Washburn has kindly walked the property with me and explained the process to me. I look forward to hearing your thoughts and comments. Below you will find a summary of the work that has started and work we are planning to do.

Work Completed

Since moving into my property, I have been cleaning up the yard. A lot of the yard was overgrown and had been left for a while. My yard has a lot of pine trees. There is a row that surrounds two sides of the house which also lead into the area in question. The pines are very tall and on most the branches don't start till about 30' and above. This has led them to be very vulnerable to wind. Some of these trees have been snapping and more will soon. One tree hit our pool last year and branches fall after every storm. The trees that have been cut are mostly pines and some standing dead trees. Also, in the area in question there was dead fallen trees that have been clean up. There was and is piles of debris including removed ~~bitter~~ ^{stumps} in the area. These piles were created by back blading the area to be able to work safely.

Work TO Complete

The goal for the area in the rear of our property is make it a beautiful usable outdoor space. We plan to even out the area and plant grass. We would also like to add a 16'x16'x6" crushed stone patio. The debris piles will be spread, the stumps will be ground and 0"-2" inches of topsoil will be added where needed. Once this portion of the work is completed, we will plant the grass.
