The Electors and Citizens qualified to vote in Town Meetings of the Town of Brooklyn, Connecticut, are hereby notified and warned that a Town Meeting of said Town will be held at the Brooklyn Middle School, Gorman Road, Brooklyn, Connecticut on the 21st day of November, 2022, at 7:00 P.M. for the following purposes:

- ITEM 1. To choose a moderator for said meeting.
2. To discuss and vote to authorize the Town to purchase, for the sum of \$1.00, the real property, and the buildings and improvements thereon, located at 31 Tiffany Street, Brooklyn, CT from the Brooklyn Housing Authority, which property is known as the Brooklyn Community Center, and, in furtherance of the foregoing, to authorize the First Selectman, in consultation with the Town Attorney, to execute, on behalf of the Town, such documents and take such actions as are reasonably appropriate to carry out said transaction.
 3. To determine the wishes of those present and eligible to vote upon a proposed Ordinance Amending an Ordinance creating a Planning and Zoning Commission. A copy of said ordinance is on file in the Office of the Town Clerk and First Selectman and available for public inspection during normal business hours.
 4. To determine the wishes of those present and eligible to vote upon a sale of land between the Town of Brooklyn and Zachary Credit in the amount of \$21,000; Map ID 41-19, .84 acres, on Claudia Avenue. Complete property description is on file in the Office of the Town Clerk and First Selectman and available for public inspection during normal business hours.
 5. To determine the wishes of those present and eligible to vote upon a sale of land between the Town of Brooklyn and Alice and Arthur Hall in the amount of \$15,000; Map ID 49-163 and 49-163a, .65 acres and .14 acres, on Paradise Drive and Short Street. Complete property description is on file in the Office of the Town Clerk and First Selectman and available for public inspection during normal business hours.

6. As recommended by the Board of Selectmen and Board of Finance, to consider and act on a resolution to approve the following transfers:




