## RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE \$315,715 FOR THE 2022-2023 CAPITAL FUNDING PROGRAM

## BE IT RESOLVED:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the Town of Brooklyn appropriate \$315,715 for the costs of the 2022-2023 Capital Funding Program, consisting of the following:

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The appropriation may be expended for construction costs and materials, equipment, purchase costs, legal fees, financing costs, and other costs related to the projects. The appropriation shall include any federal, state or other grants-in-aid received for the projects. The amount authorized to be expended for each purpose shall not exceed the amount set forth opposite each purpose, provided that the Board of Selectmen may, after approval of the Board of Finance, transfer unexpended funds among purposes, so long as the total appropriation is not increased. The Board of Selectmen may reduce the scope of any project if funds are insufficient to complete the entire project, and the entire appropriation may be spent on the reduced project.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That the First Selectman and, if applicable, the Board of Education, is authorized to apply for and accept or reject grants-in-aid for the projects; and the First Selectman is authorized to contract with engineers, architects, contractors and others on behalf of the Town for the projects.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. That the First Selectman is authorized to execute agreements and other documents on behalf of the Town for the projects; and that the Board of Selectmen, Board of Finance, Treasurer and other Town officials and employees are authorized to take all actions necessary and proper to carry out the projects.
