1. Consider and act upon the following proposed "Smoking Ordinance": **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF BROOKLYN that the following "NO SMOKING, VAPING OR OTHER TOBACCO OR CANNABIS USE" Ordinance is hereby adopted as an Ordinance of the Town:**

The Board of Selectmen may use the sum of \$53,000 that has been returned to the Town from the Quinebaug Regional Park Development towards the cost of constructing a new roof at the former Town Garage at 61 South Main Street, Brooklyn, Ct., that use of said funds having been approved by the Board of Finance and the Board of Selectmen.

4. Consider and act upon the following Resolution: **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF BROOKLYN that:**

The Board of Selectmen may use up to \$74,000 of the State LOCIP funds towards the cost of constructing a new roof at the former Town Garage at 61 South Main Street, Brooklyn, Ct., that use of said funds having been approved by the Board of Finance and the Board of Selectmen.
