TOWN OF BROOKLYN WARNING OF ANNUAL TOWN MEETING MAY 24, 2023

The electors and those persons eligible to vote in town meetings of the Town of Brooklyn, Connecticut, are hereby warned and notified that the Annual Town Meeting will be held at the Brooklyn Middle School Auditorium, 119 Gorman Road, Brooklyn, Connecticut, on May 24, 2023 at 7:00 pm for the following purposes:

ITEM 1. To choose a moderator for said meeting.

ITEM 2. To hear and act upon the General Town Government Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024 in the amount of \$6,640,396.00, as recommended by the Board of Finance.

ITEM 3. To hear and act upon the Board of Education Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024, in the amount of \$21,635,600.00, as recommended by the Board of Finance.

ITEM 4. To discuss and vote on a Resolution:

(a) To appropriate \$213,121.00 for the costs of the 2023-2024 Capital Funding Program, consisting of various capital projects for the Town; and

(b) To authorize the First Selectman and, if applicable, the Board of Education, to apply for and accept or reject grants-in-aid for the projects, and to authorize the First Selectman to execute agreements and other documents on behalf of the Town for the projects and the financing of the projects.

ITEM 5. To resolved to authorize the Board of Selectmen to utilize up to \$110,000.00 in LOCIP funds along with a STEAP grant to install a generator for the Senior Center and the Clifford B. Green Building.
