- emergency management directors
- fire and police incident commanders
- communications/dispatch professionals
- public works directors, and

ARE THESE ASSETS AVAILABLE TO US?

Assets may be deployed to support local, regional, or State emergency response and recovery. Assets *may* be available to support communications and safety at non-emergencies, such as large community gatherings or planned major system outages. *Emergencies always take priority for deployment and use*.

the local emergency management director
(EMD) who will coordinate with regional ESF
leadership and the DEMHS Regional
Coordinator. Know your EMD and Deputy EMD!
