In undertaking the zoning regulation update, the Planning and Zoning Commission is considering options for dealing with clothing donation bins. As you know, they tend to pop up overnight and can be unsightly dumping grounds.

One of the options discussed was a zoning regulation that only allowed them at the Brooklyn Transfer Station. Obviously, the Resource Recovery Authority would have ultimate jurisdiction on the matter of what can be located at the Transfer Station including any policies had been developed for that purpose.

I am asking that the Resource Recovery Commission discuss the topic of potentially more donation bins at the Transfer Station at their next regular meeting.

If I cannot be there personally, a representative from PZC will likely attend.



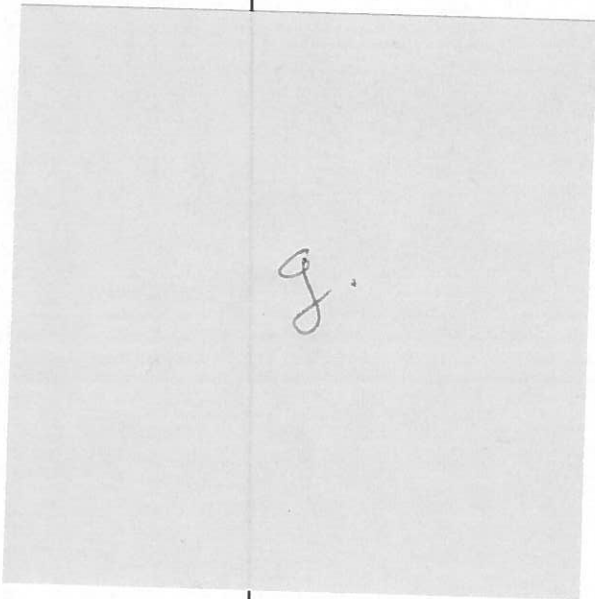
