Lisa applied for a grant and was awarded 1000.00 for the Teen Center the money will be used to purchase items to enhance the center.

There are 27 teens that are members of the Center.

The logo was chosen from a contest where the teens submitted their ideas for the logo.

Mike Gaudreau feels the teen center is moving forward and doing very well.

The Center will also be getting new outside LED lighting. Next year enrollment will be open to sixth graders, too.
