Summer Camp rates will be as follows:

There will be an increase of 30.00. There will be no increase for non-residents.

This increase, for six weeks of camp ,equals 5 dollars a week. Early bird registration for summer camp will equal 75.00 per week. The total fee will be 450.00

Teen Summer camp fees will also increase 30.00

This increase, for six weeks of camp equals 5 dollars a week. Early bird registrations of Teen summer camp will 330.00. There will be no increase for non-residents.

Before and After School Recreation Fees

Before School remains the same 25.00 per week +20.00 reg fee

After School will be 50.00 per week +20.00 reg fee

Before/ After school combo will be 65.00 per week +20.00 reg fee
