3. 2017/18 Budget Discussion

The subcommittee presented the proposed budget to the commission.

It is a fair but aggressive budget. On the expense side there are contractual increases for employees of 2.5%. Gas, and Electricity have increased and well as payroll for part-time summer employees, due to the

minimum wage increase required by the state. There is 2500.00 put in for a concert series at Riverside Park during the summer.

The overall increase in the Recreation budget is 5.15%. The overall increase in the Parks and maintenance budget is 5.7

On the revenue side, there is a proposed increase of 10% in revenue, with the increase in fees of Summer Camp and Before and After School programs.

Mae Lyons feels that the school should pay Parks and Rec. for cleaning the sidewalks and other nonrecreational services that are now in the Parks and Recreation Budget.
