Applications are being accepted for full-time positions within the Town of Brooklyn. Applicant must have a high school diploma or GED and hold current CT certifications in Firefighter II, Haz-Mat Ops, NIMS 700, EMT, CPR, and AED.

Required Experience: Currently employed as a full-time career firefighter/EMT with a minimum of seven (7) years of continuous service. Applications will be accepted from candidates with less than (7) years of full-time career FF/EMT experience if the candidate has passed the CT Fire Academy Recruit Class. Non-career FF/EMT candidates qualify for consideration with a minimum of seven (7) consecutive years of volunteer service in good standing, possess CT Fire Officer I, and have passed the CT Fire Academy Recruit Class.

Additional requirements include a minimum of five (5) years' experience in ambulance transport, possessing a valid candidate physical agility test (CPAT) within the past two (2) years, and a CT CDL Class B license or 2Q endorsement. CT Certifications from Pump Operator, Aerial Operator, Instructor I, and Officer II are highly desired, but not required.

Skills and Experience

- Candidate shall possess general knowledge of elementary physics, chemistry, and mechanics; possession of mechanical aptitude; ability to perform heavy manual labor; skilled in the operation of heavy emergency equipment.
- Candidate shall possess general knowledge of technical firefighting principles and techniques and principles of hydraulics applied to fire suppression, and general knowledge of emergency care methods, techniques, and equipment.
- Candidate shall possess general knowledge of the street system and physical layout of the Town of Brooklyn
- Candidate shall be able to understand and follow oral and written instructions; also, must be able to speak professionally and establish and maintain cooperative relationships with fellow employees and the public.
- Candidate shall be computer literate and be able to quickly learn to prepare reports using fire department report-based software and utilize limited Microsoft applications including Outlook.
