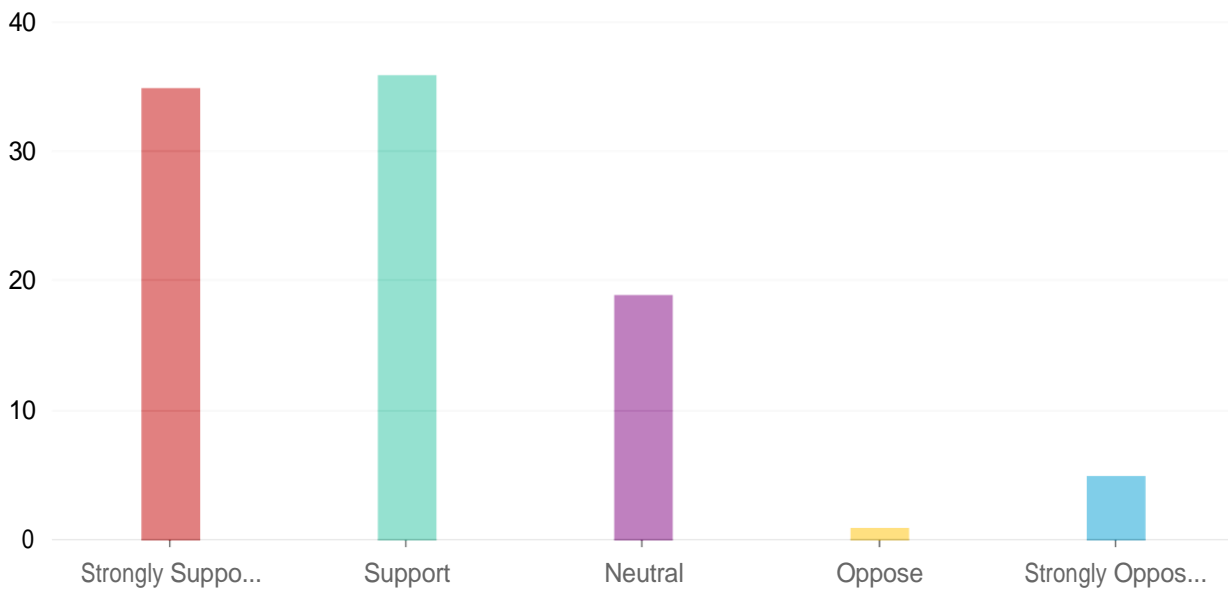


# Town of Brooklyn ARPA Funds Survey

What do you support using ARPA funds for?

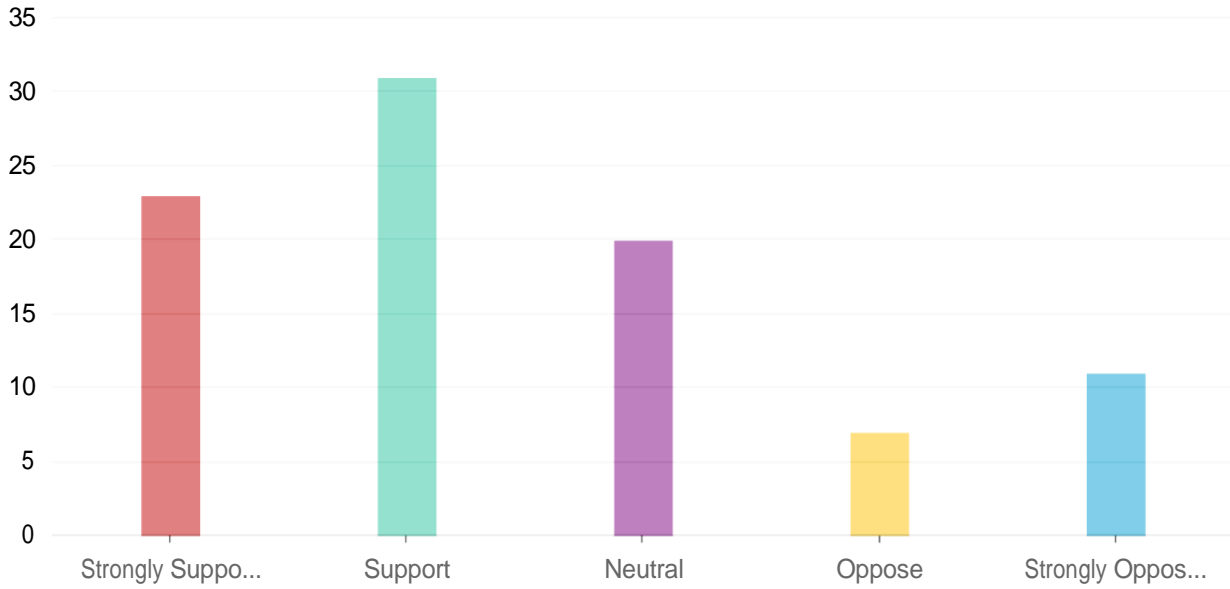

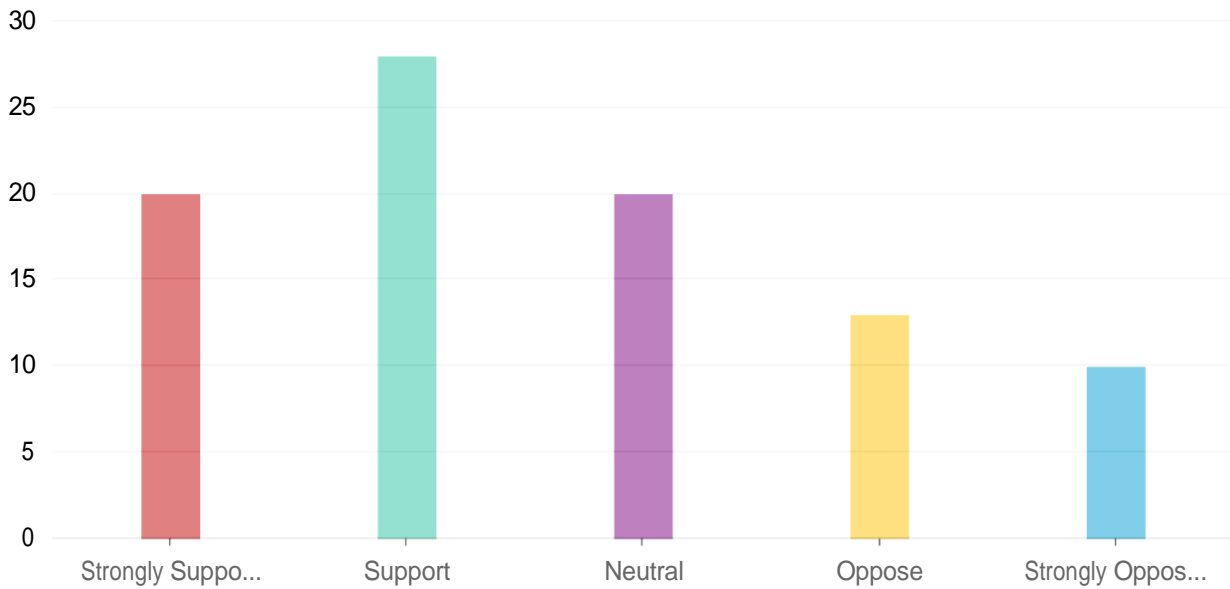

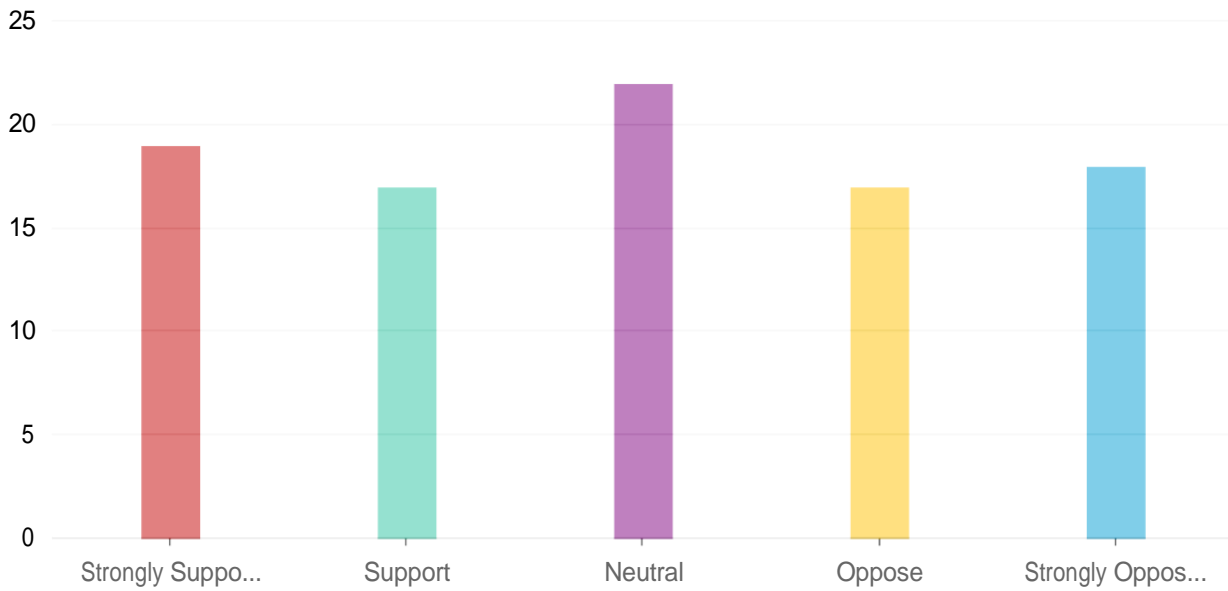

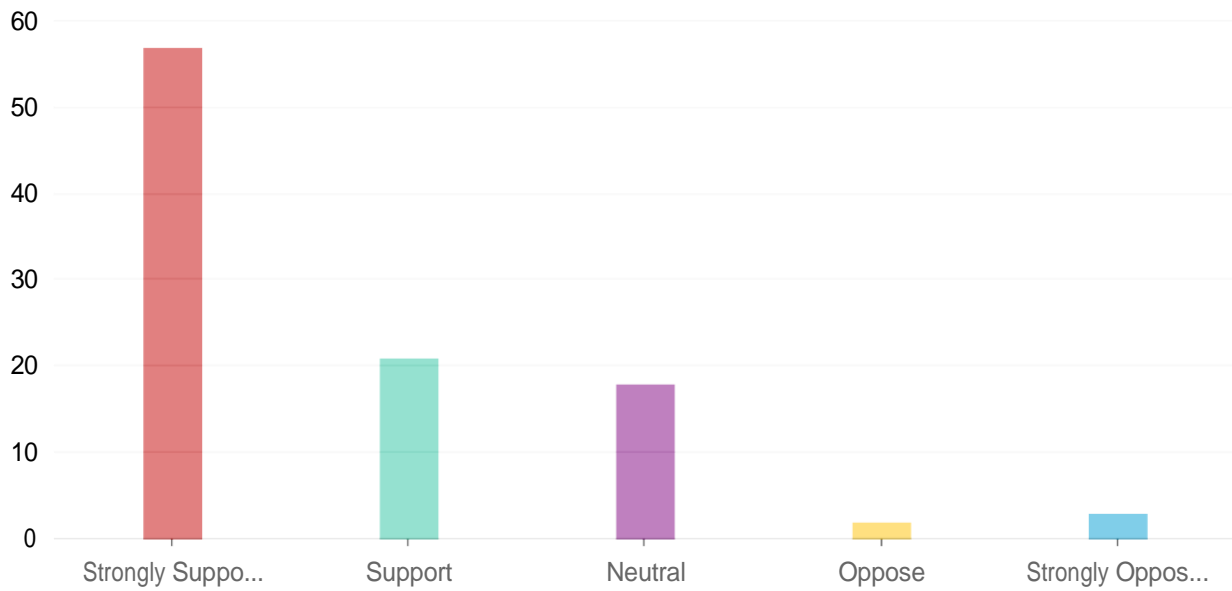

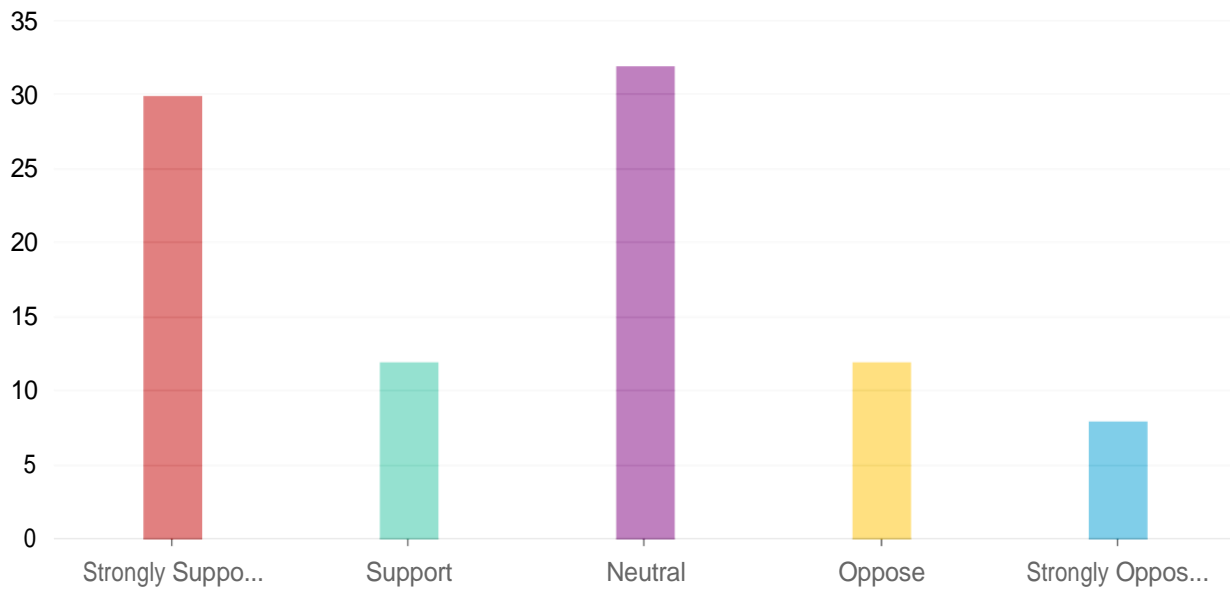
● Town Infrastructure
